**LIBRARY DISTRICT  
BOUNDARY  
ESTABLISHMENT CRITERIA**

- Boundary aligns with voting precincts for efficiency of election administration
- Boundary does not overlap with any other municipality's service area or another library district
  - Per the "Super IGA" - Boulder County Countywide Coordinated Comprehensive Development Plan Intergovernmental Agreement
- Boundary includes the largest number of households with Boulder Public Library cards in accordance with the previous two criteria.

# PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

- **Library District proposed funding plan objective:**  
**Fund the 2018 Boulder Public Library Master Plan.**
- **Master Plan Funding Level Definitions**
  - Maintain Services = Fiscally constrained
  - Address Community Demand = Action
  - Service Expansion = Vision
- **Summary of Current Programs and Services – memo Attachment A**  
“Under” funded designation due to 2020-2021 COVID-19 related budget reductions
- **Master Plan Goals and Objectives – memo Attachment B**  
“Not” funded designation indicates not yet implemented

# PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

**2019 Library Financial Analysis estimated costs based on the proposed boundary for:**

- Implementing all Master Plan goals
- Adding a Corner Library in Niwot at nominal rent
- Catching up on deferred maintenance and funding ongoing maintenance

Maintain Service Levels	\$14.5 million
Address Community Demand	\$18.9 million
Service Expansion	\$20 million
