#### Quarter 2: April – June 2023

#### Website


Both the number of sessions and the number of new users increased since Q2 2022. Notably, pages per session and average session duration both decreased in comparison with last year. This may indicate that current visitors have very specific research interests and/or are easily finding the information they seek. As noted in previous reports, over half of all users access the site via a mobile device or tablet. A majority of patrons continue to find materials via organic search, indicating Carnegie's digital collections remain easily accessible to search engines.



## Social Media


